

The keeping of poultry in gazetted townships within the District Council of Lower Eyre Peninsula boundaries must comply with the following requirements:

- 1 A maximum of 12 hens be kept;
- 2 A suitable shed of 6 sq m in area be provided with a concrete floor;
- 3 Roosters shall not be permitted in townships other than in the Rural Living Zones in the townships of Boston and Tiatukia and that they be restricted to maximum of 2 roosters per allotment;
- 4 The shed will be sited a minimum of 8 metres from any dwelling house;
- 5 Open runs may be allowed if deemed suitable by the General Inspector following an inspection.
