The keeping of dogs and cats is limited to no more than two dogs and no more than two cats on any allotment situated within the Residential, Settlement, Coastal Settlement, Town Centre, Mixed Use (Pt Boston) and Rural Living zones in the District Council of Lower Eyre Peninsula.

Exceptions to the above policy are available in extenuating circumstances with approval of the General Inspector or Manager Development & Environmental Services with assessment of the property for suitability.

Any such exception is not ongoing and will only apply to the animals living at the property at that point in time.
